Cancellation and Event Refund Policy

- All refund or future event credit requests must be submitted via email to cheri@nasautah.com
 Entry fees cannot be transferred between NASA regions.
- Entry fees cannot be transferred to another driver.
- Once the car hits the track all fees are non-refundable.
- Registration fees are fully refundable, less a \$50 processing fee, with at least 5 days notice prior to the start of the event. (Monday prior to the event at 11:59 PM)
- If within 5 days of the event, no refunds or credits will be available. If you choose to select an event credit vs. a refund you will not endure the \$50 processing fee but you are still required to give 5 days notice.

NASA Stickers, Patches, Numbers, Etc.

NASA Stickers, Patches, Car Numbers, Race Car log books, and other miscellaneous items are available at the NASA Utah Office during our event weekends. Due to rising expenses we need to charge a small amount cover the cost of these small items.

Track Cleanup & Repair Costs

Track repair and cleanup charges will be charged to event participant immediately after the incident.

- Track absorbent-\$50 per bag
- Guard Rail-\$50 LF
- Asphalt-\$500 per SQ FT
- Tire Safety Barrier-\$60 LF
- Chain link Fencing-\$25 LF
- Track Clean-\$100 per hour Forklift Use-\$150 per hour
- Shipping (load or offload)-\$100
- Airfence-\$1,300 LF

Fuel Availability

UMC does have fuel available on-site, as of this document we're unsure of ratings other than 91 Octane

Tire Disposal

UMC does not offer on-site tire disposal. If you brought it in, please take it with you, or arrange with a shop to dispose of your tires. If you are caught leaving tires UMC can charge a hefty amount for disposal.

Event Photographs

Garages and Camping

Updated 5/14/24

Garage rentals and camping are handled by UMC. You can check availability and make reservations on their website.

- Gate Hours 6am-10pm during events
- RV Spots, Day and GP garages
 - Wristbands for after-hours gate access will be provided in your reservation packet for you and your guests. These must be worn the entire event in order to have access in and out of the gate <u>24/7</u>.
 - Entry to the facility for your reservation is <u>7pm-10pm</u> on the first day of your reservation.
 - If checking in after 10pm you will be asked to park outside gate till 6am
 - o Check-out <u>6pm</u> on the last day of your reservation
- Overnight parking NO Camping!
 - Let security know you'll be leaving a trailer for overnight parking for NASA event
 - Security will provide wristbands for after-hours gate access at the time of entry
 - o Move in <u>7pm-10pm</u> night before event, or <u>starting at 6am</u> day of event
 - If checking in after 10pm you will be asked to park outside gate till 6am
 - Green areas on Paddock Map Only. Do not block Cart Center guest parking
 - o Check-out 6pm last day of event

Fire Extinguishers

UMC requires each paddock and pit space to bring their own fire extinguisher.

Electric Vehicles

Because of increased risk if there is a fire on an electric vehicle, UMC will require an additional EV waiver be signed, a minimum of 1 all metal tow hook on vehicle, and 4 EV stickers for quick identification in case of emergency.
